Coding Camp

Lloyd Learning, Inc. is a nonprofit organization dedicated to preparing underrepresented female students for the global science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) workforce. The **Starfish STEM Academy** is an informal learning program implemented by the Lloyd Learning organization to: (1) offer STEM camps and workshops at **NO COST** or **LOW COST** to underrepresented female students; (2) increase STEM opportunities and career paths in STEM fields for underrepresented female students; and (3) reduce gender barriers and achievement gaps for underrepresented female students. In collaboration with **Countryside High School** and **St. Petersburg College**, STEM camps will be offered in June. STEM workshops will be conducted 1-2 Saturdays on a monthly basis throughout the academic school year.

CODING CAMP: During a 4-day camp, students will learn the basics of coding and game design using drag and drop block programming. No coding experience is required. Students will select one of two sessions being offered.
